Table 2: Steps in the Treatment of Acute Stroke in the Emergency Department by the Stroke Team

- 1. Assess airway, breathing, and circulation.
- **2.** History and physical examinations to confirm acute focal neurologic deficit.
- **3.** Exclude stroke mimics: hypoglycemia, seizure, conversion disorder, and migraine.
- 4. Noncontrast head computed tomography to exclude intracerebral hemorrhage.
- 6. Does patient meet intravenous (IV) rt-PA* criteria? See package insert.

5. Obtain fasting blood sugar, complete blood count, and platelets.

- 7. Intravenous hydration to ensure cerebral perfusion.
- 8. Aspiration precautions.
- 9. If patient does not meet IV rt-PA criteria, give 81 mg of aspirin.
- 10. Admit to stroke unit for careful monitoring.
